Youth Empowerment Program

In partnership with Tipping Point Foundation and Housing Authority of the County of San Mateo, MHA is launching the Youth Empowerment Program (YEP) which will pair young adults who are homeless or at risk of homelessness with intensive case management and support services to help them become more independent and self-sufficient. These are individuals who face significant barriers to housing stability. The program will provide rental subsidies to help clients secure and maintain long-term housing, while also developing or improving independent living skills, strengthening positive social support networks, and help them to improve potential vocational opportunities through education and skill building activities. Clients will also be connected to needed medical, mental health and financial support services. Contact Terriana Briggs to learn more about eligibility for YEP.

ARISE program gets a boost from the MHSA Act

MHA's pilot project, ARISE, has been funded for three years with a grant from the MHSA Innovation funds. The MHSA funding is designed to expand and transform the behavioral health system to better serve individuals with serious mental health issues.

MHA's ARISE program matches in-home support workers with clients who need additional assistance with maintaining housing. We match providers and individuals who, without this type of support, were in danger of losing their housing in the next six months. This demonstration project has been an overwhelming success, informing us about how this will work with the larger segment of the population in need.
