# New Supportive Housing in Redwood City

Casa Esperanza, one of San Mateo County's HomeKey programs, officially completed rehabilitation in January, 2023 and it is expected that all 52 units will be occupied by the end of February. MHA staff are partnering



with Alta Housing, the building owner and operator, to provide a range of supportive on-site services for residents including Case Management, Occupational Therapy, Information and Referral for outside services. Residents may be connected to behavioral healthcare services, healthcare services, educational programs, social and recreational activities, and financial entitlements as needed. With the help of Life Science Cares and the staff at Rain Oncology, residents received Welcome Kits including linens, towels and bathmats, food and cooking supplies and basic hygiene items. We look forward to sharing pictures and stories about the difference this program, and programs like it, are making in the lives of people who have been homeless.

## MHA launches the ARISE Program

An important aspect of supportive housing is helping clients with services outside of regular case management. Some clients need additional services in order to thrive in supportive housing. Help with meal prep, cleaning or walking a dog can make all the difference in a successful housing placement.

MHA has developed a pilot project, recruiting and matching in-home workers with our clients who need additional assistance to maintain housing. We identified five care providers along with more than 20 individuals who, without this type of support, were in danger of losing their housing in the next six months. This demonstration project has been an overwhelming success, informing us about how this will work with the larger segment of the population in need.

The program is currently under consideration for a four-year extension through MHSA Innovative Funding and we are extremely hopeful that we can launch an expanded version within the next few months.
